

Care and maintenance WPC Wall Cladding

WPC cladding is low maintenance material but still require regular and proper cleaning to ensure their longevity and continued beauty. Below we will provide comprehensive guide on how to maintain your wpc wall cladding.

Regular cleaning

To keep the wpc cladding in its condition you will need to do regular cleaning. How often you should clean depends upon where it's installed such as internal setting or external setting. But you should give visual inspection to find out if it is time to give it a clean. Simply follow these steps for regular cleaning.

1. Dust removal: Use soft bristle brush to remove loose particles first.

2. Wipe down: Prepare cleaning solution mixing warm water and mild detergent. Then gently wipe down the panels in the direction of flutes or grooves.

Removal of stains and dirts

Below is procedure for removal of common stains caused by accident and high humid condition.

1. Food and beverage stains: Immediately clean with damp cloth and mild detergent. Then rinse the area and let it dry thoroughly.

2. Grease and oil: Mix mild detergent and warm water, apply to the stain and gently scrub with soft cloth. Then rinse the area and let it dry thoroughly.

3. Mildew and mould: Use hot soapy water with soft bristle brush and gently scrub it. Alternatively you can use mould remover which you can find in your local hardware shop.

4. Ink or marker stain: Mould can build up in any areas due to constant moisture and shade. So it's necessary to remove it soon as you notice to prevent from further spreading. Use hot soapy water with soft bristle brush. Alternatively you can use mould remover which you can find in your local hardware shop.
